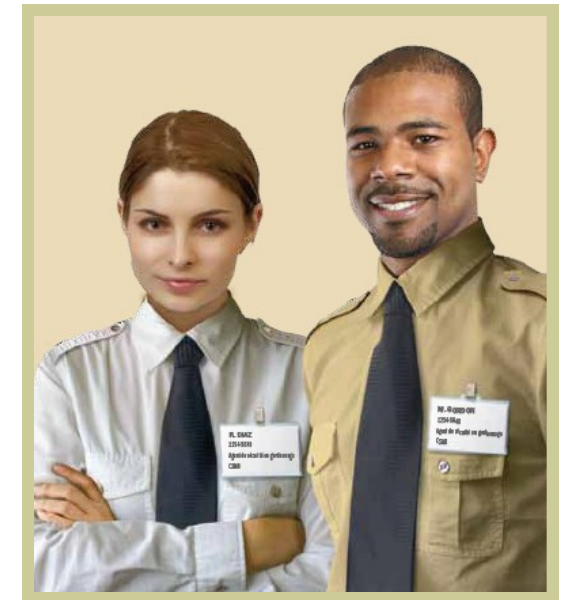

The basic training program is based on the *Private Security Act* and related regulations respecting:

- the standards of behaviour of private security guards
- private security training

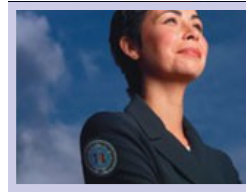
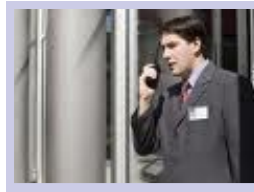


A minimum of 15 participants per session.

Session will begin pending sufficient number of participants.

The program meets the requirements of the Canadian General Standards Board for Security Officers and Security Officer Supervisors published in March 2008.

As stipulated in paragraph 1 of section 16 of the *Private Security Act*, any person carrying on a private security activity, or who wishes to do so, must hold a licence of the appropriate class. According to section 19, an agent licence may be issued by the *Bureau de la sécurité privée*, if the applicant meets the following conditions:

- Have the training required by regulation
- Be of good moral character
- Never have been convicted, in any place, of an offence for an act or omission that is an offence under the Criminal Code (Revised Statutes of Canada, 1985, chapter C-46) or an offence referred to in section 183 of that Code under one of the Acts listed in that section and is related to the activity for which the agent licence application is filed, unless the applicant has obtained a pardon;
- Be at least 18 years of age and
- Meet any other condition determined by regulation.
